Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Tulane Living Well Employee Flu Fair?

The Tulane Employee Flu Fair is an annual event that provides Tulane employees and staff with convenient access to the seasonal influenza vaccine before the start of flu season.

Why should I get a flu vaccine?

The flu vaccine helps reduce your risk of getting influenza, decreases the severity of illness if you do get sick, and helps protect your family, coworkers, patients, and our community.

Who is eligible to receive a flu vaccine at the Flu Fair?

The Flu Fair is available to all Tulane employees and staff.

Is there a cost?

The flu vaccine is provided at no cost to Tulane employees and staff. Insurance information may be requested as part of the registration process.

Do I need an appointment?

Appointments are preferred but not required. Employees and staff are encouraged to schedule an appointment using the link on our homepage, [Tulane Living Well](#), to help minimize wait times.

Walk-ins will be accepted during scheduled Flu Fair hours.

What should I bring?

Please bring:

- Your Tulane Splashcard.
- Your insurance card.
- Flu Shot Screening Form.

Will there be documentation of my vaccination?

Yes. The flu shots will be documented in the Louisiana State Immunization Registry; please allow up to two weeks for the vaccine to be documented. You can also download your immunization record by logging on to the Tulane Living Well Occupational Health Patient Portal (<https://health.healow.com/tulaneocc>).

Will COVID vaccines or boosters be available?

No. Only flu vaccinations will be offered at these events. Please discuss any other vaccines you're interested in with your primary care provider.
